Chippewa County 4-H Leaders Inc. voted on a new reimbursement policy for those wishing to submit reimbursements for programs like Art Beat, State Fair, Fall Forum etc. Youth will be eligible to receive 50% of the program fee & lodging up to \$200 back by filling out the form and submitting receipts. For example, Art Beat costs \$80, the youth will be eligible for \$40 in reimbursement. A youth shows a swine at the State Fair and the registration/lodging in the dorm costs \$600, the youth will be eligible for up to \$200.
