The fair is upon us! Here are a few helpful reminders as we prepare for it!

Cloverbuds & Explorers: Please sign up for a judging time slot on Sign Up Genius. The link can be found in the Jr. Fair Book or here: Cloverbud/Exploring Judging

Fair registrations are now closed! Your exhibitor tags will be mailed in the following week. Please be patient as fair staff prepare for the fair!

Animal Exhibitors: Please send your YQCA the fair. It is a fair requirement NOT a 4-H requirement. If yours has been dropped off at the Extension Office, it will be brought up to the fair. If you are part of the Quality Meats program this will be checked upon arrival.

Also, please make sure you are providing the fair with your Premise ID number. You can enter it in Blue Ribbon, call with the number or stop into the Fair Office with that information. In order to be in compliance with the health inspector, these need to be on file!

Club Booths: To the right is a picture of the club booths. If clubs plan on having a table in their booth, a 6 ft plastic table will fit and needs to be provided by the club. Judging for booths will be at 3 pm on Tuesday, July 9. A club member can be present to talk to the judge. Booths can be set up on July 6, 8 or 9 as the building will be open. Booths must be up by judging.

Youth Building Project Pick Up: Please note that there was an error in date for project pick up at the NWSF. Projects MUST be picked up on Sunday, July 14 (not 15) from 5-7 pm. Please arrange for your projects to be picked up during this time.

Chippewa County 4-H Camp offers an excellent opportunity for youth to make new friends, learn new camping skills, and enjoy the outdoors. 4-H camp registration is open to 4-Her's between now and **July 1**.
