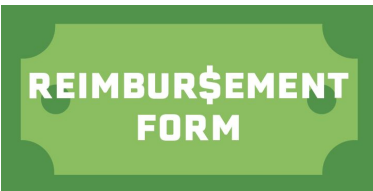
The 2018-2019 4-H year is coming to a close! Registration for the 2019-2020 4-H Year will open on Thursday, September 5th. 4-H Online will be unavailable to 4-H families and leaders from August 30-September 4. Please print any reports you need before August 30.

As the 4-H Calendar year comes to a close, please submit any outstanding bills ASAP to the Chippewa County Extension Office for payment by Leader's Council. This includes those seeking reimbursement for state and national experiences, state fair etc.



The form is due October 1, 2019 with receipts attached or copies of payments issued. Please note: registration forms do not count as receipts. Any reimbursement requests must include your club's general leader, please plan accordingly to get this signature.

Programs not eligible for reimbursement include 4-H Camp, 5th to 8th Grade WI Adventure Experience, Clover College and Clover University. These programs already receive funding from Leader's Council and it is reflected in the registration fees.
