Why am I pending? Pending means a youth or adult is enrolled in 4-H, but has not been approved at the county level. Youth may be pending as they need club approval by paying their club dues before the county approves them. Please check with your club enrollment coordinator to determine whether your family has paid their dues. The club enrollment coordinator must be enrolled and active before approving members.

Re-enrolling adults may be pending as once every four years, they must do a background check and check their volunteer role in 4-H online. New volunteers may be pending for four reasons: background check, need to attend VIP training, need a volunteer role and needs to take mandated reporter training. Please check with Heidi to determine why you are still pending. Pending volunteers CANNOT serve in the volunteer capacity until they are approved. Approvals for volunteers are done at the county level ONLY.



Volunteers and youth will be approved each Monday at the county level.
