Save the Date for two Chippewa County 4-H Educational Travel Experiences in summer 2020!

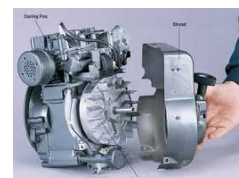
The 2020 5-8 Grade Adventure Experience will be held **June 16-18** and our destination is Green Bay! Tentative activities include: Bay Beach Nature Preserve, Bay Beach Amusement Park, Lambeau Field Tour, the Neville Public Museum and more! The cost will be around \$150 and includes meals, lodging and transportation. Registration will open April 1.



The 2020 9-12 Out of State Adventure Experience will be held **June 8-12** and will be heading to St. Louis, MO! Possible activities include: Mark Twain history in Hannibal, Gateway Arch, St. Louis Zoo, City Museum, Cahokia Mounds, the Laumeier Sculpture park and more.
