1. **Clothing Revue judging will be held on Saturday, April 18, 2020 at the Lafayette Town Hall at 10 a.m.**

2. Modeling at the fair is required in order to receive a premium.

3. **The Clothing Revue Style Show will be held at the NWSF, Sunday July 12 at 2 PM** Clothing Construction garments modeled in the Clothing Revue may be entered as a clothing exhibit.

4. Members must be 12 years of age as of January 1 of this year, for State Fair Clothing Revue- Milwaukee.

5. Members will not be allowed to be the 1st delegate in State Fair Clothing Revue for two consecutive years.

6. If the winner this year was the 1st delegate last year, that member will become the 1st alternate and the 2nd place winner will become the 1st delegate.

7. Construction entries will be judged on:
(a) suitability of garment to individual and purpose as to color and design; (b) general appearance - neatness, posture, fit; (c) construction to the extent that it affects general appearance; (d) suitability of accessories.

9. Looking Good entries will be judged on suitability of garment and accessories, general appearance, value and knowledge of selection factors.

10. Garments will be conference judged and participants will receive a uniform premium and a ribbon of the judge's choice.

11. Participants must register with the Extension Office by **April 6, 2020** to exhibit and must register with the Northern Wisconsin State Fair Entry Department by their deadline to receive premiums.

Cloverbuds-Open to all persons enrolled in **4-H Cloverbuds** program (Grades K-2) or comparable pre-beginner program. Exhibitors limited to one (1) entry.
