



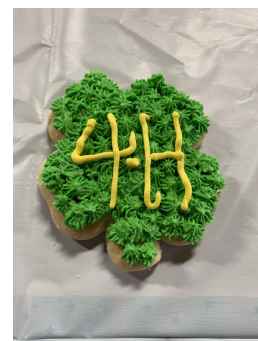
Chippewa Chatter
