Chippewa County 4-H's Ice Fishing day is on Saturday, February 20 at Kamp Kenwood. The day is open to fishers of all ability levels and learn to fish options will be available. Youth will learn the fundamentals of ice fishing, what to do with their catch and ice fishing safety.

The program will be open to the first 38 youth in grades 3 and up to comply with risk management. Youth start and end times will be staggered between noon and 5 pm in four hour time slots.
