Get your hands dirty Digging Deeper into 4-H this spring! Youth in 4-8 grades from Chippewa, Dunn and Eau Claire counties are invited to participate in this hands-on virtual program. Each Thursday night starting April 1, live sessions will be offered to engage in the hands-on learning with 4-H Educators and 4-H volunteers. These sessions will also be recorded for youth to complete if they cannot attend a Thursday night!
