

Chippewa County Quality Meats Educational Requirements Options

(How to meet the requirements to sell)

1. Attend a virtual class or webinar based on livestock. Our UW Extension (Bernie O'Rourke has great information for youth at any age. Link can be found on the bottom of page.
2. Find YouTube videos on livestock industry or the following examples.
 - Ultra Sound – What does this mean? How my animal is judged based on this?
 - Show Animals vs Commercial Animals- How to pick out quality animals for the fair?
 - Animal Nutrition – What to feed your feed animal for the cost of feed. Different options to create a competitive animal for show day or carcass show.
 - Animal Handling – How to handle animals. Learn to read the animal's body language. Learn better techniques to save time.
 - Livestock judging – Judge classes of Swine, Beef, and Sheep from videos commercial and show quality animals. (can be done on Instagram also)
 - Watch Livestock show across the country. They are recorded. Example (North American International Livestock, American Royal, National Western Stock Show, Fort Worth Stock Show) these are some of the largest shows in the world, every animal in these shows are high quality and fun to watch how they are judged and the reasons behind it. (you might recognize some of the faces showing too)
 - Do Edpuzzles on livestock industry.
3. Attend an educational event on livestock held in the county. (Example Beef Clinics, Sheep clinics, & Swine Clinics, etc..... (Times and dates will be announce at future meetings)
4. Attend an educational event on livestock held outside the county. (Example Kids & Cows, Swine Jackpot Shows, Livestock Judging, State Fair, Wool Festival, other County Fairs, etc.....)
5. For college or Tech age members participating in the Quality Meats Program, if you take an AG related class in college or tech this will count.

This page is an example of options. If there is an educational item that is not listed but you feel will qualify, please ask the educational chairperson for approval. *Members can attend species event that the member does not participate in. (Example I will be showing hogs at the fair but attend a beef event.)
