The April 1 - June 1 program guidance is here! Approval forms are still required except if the meeting or program is under two hours AND less than 20 people. Summer information will be available after April 1.

Indoors: 30% of room capacity, up to 50 people. If the room capacity is 100, you can have 30 people indoors. Face coverings are required indoors.

Outdoors: Up to 150 people that can be in pods or amphitheater style seating.

Forms will be provided to club leaders and general leaders tomorrow, 3/9. If you are planning an in-person program, please submit your form to Heidi 10 business days before your planned program to allow time for approval. If you'd like to schedule a time to connect over a program, please email Heidi at heidi.vanderloop@wisc.edu.

An email went out to Chippewa County 4-H Shooting Sports air rifle and BB participants from 2019-2020 with registration information for this year's programming. Only returning shooters will be allowed to participate in this year's program to ensure safety of participants and volunteers.

Stay tuned for more information about upcoming programming as the committee will be looking for opportunities for both new and returning shooters.

"4-H Art U" is a collaboration between A.I.M. at UW-Stout and Chippewa, Dunn and Eau Claire 4-H programs. Youth will participate in projects each Monday in April.
